The Cunard liner 'Queen Elizabeth', heir to a proud tradition established by the original Queen Mary, Queen Elizabeth and later by the Queen Elizabeth 2, is our civilized

conveyance to Alaska, the Great Land. We begin with free or low-cost train travel to Seattle from any US point along with a two-night hotel stay to avoid any concern about tight same-day connections. You'll witness local life with hardy fishermen working on crab trawlers catching local delicacies like King Crab, Octopus, Shark, Prawns and Rock fish. It is not only known as Alaska's First City due to geographically being the first place travelers stopped when heading North, it is also a figurehead of the outstanding natural beauty of Alaska.

Jun 25 Thu Icy Strait Point

Built around a restored 1912 salmon cannery, the shops are 100% Alaskan-owned and there are restaurants, nature trails, a museum and even a beach. Bear watching is a big attraction on Chichagof Island which is home to more bears than humans.

Jun 26 Fri Tracy Arm Scenic Cruising / Juneau

Beneath an ice field that never melts, on a waterway that never freezes, Juneau is the most unusual and stunning of capitals. Home to 280 species of birds, brown and black

bears, nature lovers can also watch out for Orca and Humpback Whales here. Ashore, there's an excellent theatre and range of clubs, bars restaurants to suit all tastes.

Sitka is a hidden beauty located on the east coast of Baranof Island in south east Alaska.
